Dean & Theresa Klein established the Dean and Theresa Klein *FIRST*[®] Gracious Professionalism Engineering Scholarship at Boise State University to support undergraduate engineering students who participated with a *FIRST* Team in high school.

“Gracious Professionalism” is a term used by *FIRST* to denote a code of conduct for participants which encourages teamwork and collaboration in *FIRST* challenges. This \$1,000 renewable scholarship will be awarded to one (1) student each year, who demonstrates Gracious Professionalism in their application to Boise State University’s engineering program.

Scholarship Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship, you must:

- Have participated on a *FIRST*[®] Team during high school
 - *FIRST* Tech Challenge and/or *FIRST* Robotics Competition Participants or
 - High-school Mentor with any *FIRST* Program
- Apply and be admitted to Boise State University as a full-time student.
 - You do not need to have already been admitted at the time you apply for this scholarship.
- **Submit intent to major in the College of Engineering**
